Important: All current and legacy 4G EDIS passwords continue to work exactly as they do today.

4G EDIS Password Update 2026

What is changing: Two password types are now used:

1. Service Flag Passwords

- These are intended for normal service and diagnostics.
- Read only access
- No calibration changes or downloads
- Simplified pages for diagnostics

Available levels

- **Service Tool SuperTech:** All diagnostic tests and clear adaptives
- **Service Tool Tech:** Spark kill, DBW test, clear adaptives
- **Service Tool Faults Only:** Compression testing only

Limitations

- No road speed programming
- Calibration tools remain restricted
- Service Flag passwords still work on older EDIS versions at their original access levels

2. Calibration Passwords

- These protect PSI calibration files.
- Each calibration has a unique password
- Prevents saving full calibrations or opening files in spreadsheets
- Protects PSI calibration IP
- Single Serial Number access still allows saving a calibration from the ECM and programming the unit. Opening that file later still requires the calibration password
